





  - Email and save cases.
  - Texas content: TRCP, TRAP, TRE, Disciplinary Rules, Constitution, Administrative Code, AG opinions, and more
  - Federal content: US Code, CFR, FRCP, FRAP, FRE, FRBP, etc.
  - Simple, user-friendly mobile interface for basic searches – useful to find a case or run a natural language search.

- Download from PACER, view new filings, and email filings.
- Alternative to DkT app (login problems since IOS update).

- IOS devices only: iPhone and Ipad
- 10<sup>th</sup> edition (released Apr. 2015).
- Over 50,000 terms.
- Keyword searchable.
- Definitions and content accessible offline.
- Other free/low cost dictionary apps include: Law Lexicon, Law Dictionary, Legal Dictionary by Farlex, Legal Terms, but they have less coverage than Black's.

- Social media integration.



  - Top-ranked signature app; 50% of Fortune 500; Best of 2014 award.
  - Alternatives: DocuSign (\$20/mo. PRO), HelloSign (\$13/mo - PRO), Adobe e-sign (\$9.99/mo. PRO) and many more signature apps.
  - Tex. Bus. & Comm. Code 322.007(d): “If a law requires a signature, an electronic signature satisfies the law.”

*United States District Court, S.D. California. March 22, 2012 861 F.Supp.2d 1099 2012 WL 987290*

LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT - Benefit **Plans**. Abuse of discretion review applied to insurer's denial of long term disability benefits under **ERISA plan**.

...For an **ERISA plan** to grant **plan administrator** discretion, and thereby alter the standard of review from the default of de novo to the more lenient abuse of discretion, it is sufficient that the **ERISA plan** grant the **administrator** the right, duty, and power to determine eligibility for benefits and to construe ambiguous language or interpret **plan** terms; it is not sufficient if the **plan** merely identifies the decision-maker and lists its tasks. Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, § 2 et seq., 29 U.S.C.A. § 1001 et seq....

...When a decision by an **ERISA plan administrator** utterly fails to follow applicable procedures, the **administrator** is not exercising discretionary powers under the **plan**, and its decision should be subject to de novo review; this occurs when the **plan administrator** flagrantly violates the claims procedure. Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, § 2 et seq., 29 U.S.C.A. § 1001 et seq....

*Supreme Court of Pennsylvania. November 23, 2011 613 Pa. 186 32 A.3d 1241*

LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT - Benefit **Plans**. State statute governing effect of divorce on designation of beneficiaries was preempted by **ERISA**.





